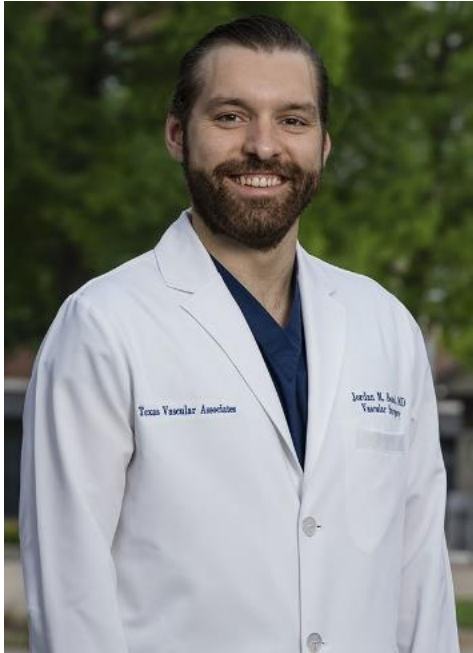
**Lisa Maehara, DO**
